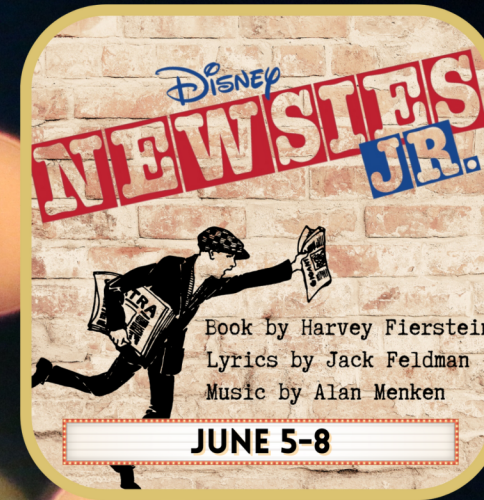
**MARCH 7-9, 14-16**
